

'How Long Will My Flag Last?'

At Tidmore Flags, we're often asked how long an outdoor flag will last. Really, there's no easy answer. Because of varying wind and weather conditions it's just not possible for us to supply you with a flag that will not eventually show wear and tear.

However, you can be sure that we'll give you the highest-quality flag your money can buy. And beyond that, there are some measures you can take to extend the life of your flag.

- Wash your flag occasionally in a mild detergent and warm water.
- When storing your flag, be certain that it is thoroughly dry.
- Mend your flag promptly when needed.
- If appropriate, fly your flag during daylight hours only. Increased fly-time is increased wear-time.
- Consider purchasing an extra flag to use on special occasions.

Conditions are different for every flag. That's why flags don't carry a specific guarantee. But you'll be taking care of your investment when you follow the simple steps above. And by doing so, we believe you'll find that your flag "hangs around" a whole lot longer.

Finally, if you're not sure what to do with an old flag, consider sending it to us. We'll be happy to respectfully retire it for you, according to U.S. Flag etiquette.
